

Positive Placement and RPSGT Exam Pass Rates

Student success is a primary goal of the Polysomnography Technology program at Temple College. Two primary measures of student achievement are positive placement and the pass rate for the Registered Polysomnographic Technologist (RPSGT) exam.

Our Polysomnography Program graduated our first cohort in May 2025. Data reflects this group only. As of this publication date, graduates have not taken the RPSGT exam.

Positive placement refers to graduates who are:

- Employed full-time or part-time in the field of polysomnography,
- Continuing their education, or
- Serving in the military.

These measures reflect our commitment to preparing graduates for meaningful careers and ongoing professional growth.
